Subject: Community Donation Applications

1.0 Purpose of Report

- 1.1 For Councillors to consider requests received for Community Donations and to agree or not to make awards to applicants.
- 1.2 Councillors are requested to read the applications in detail and be mindful of the organisation's governance, funding, support, membership and length of existence.

2.0 <u>Background Information</u>

- 2.1 The following applications (which are attached) have been received and the committee is required to make a decision on the awarding of donations based on the current criteria:
 - To provide financial support to organisations who work to improve the quality of life for residents by supporting the Town Council's objectives;
 - To provide facilities and activities which promote and support health and wellbeing as well as meeting social and leisure needs;
 - To support community involvement in local arts and cultural activities which benefit the residents of Shepton Mallet;
 - To support community participation in local sports and leisure activities to enable clubs to develop and thrive;
 - To facilitate access and sustainable transport schemes by community and voluntary activity;
 - To maintain and enhance opportunities to create a green, clean and safe environment, including biodiversity and sustainability.

- 2.2 The Community Donations budget for the financial year 2021-22 is £10,000. This is the first meeting of two for the purpose of considering Community Donation applications.
- 2.3 In addition, there is a £9,000 'Art Projects' budget allocated to this committee. It is proposed that the three applications relating to arts projects, are awarded specifically from this budget. Applications were subjected to the same scrutineering process as for the General Community Donations.
- 2.4 Total grants requested at this meeting:
 - a. General Community Donations £10,337.50
 - b. Arts Projects £6,000
- 2.5 Two further applications were received but these did not pass the screening process.
