### AWARDED DURING THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2021-22

The Council, so far, during the 21/22 financial year, gave out a total of £12856.50 in Community Donations meeting and £49,800 in Community Grants.

#### **COMMUNITY DONATIONS**

##### **Make the Sunshine - Awarded £1,500 - August 2021**

The donation was used to support the partnership project between Make the Sunshine and Shepton Mallet primary schools for the 374 Ways to Change the World creative performances.

##### **Hearthstone Ways CIC - Awarded £1,260 - August 2021**

The donation was used to support the Research Residencies project at Shepton Mallet Prison.

##### **Anglo Boxing Club - Awarded £1,000 - September 2020**

The donation enabled the club to re-floor the gym with 20mm Gym floor matting.

##### **Shepton Mallet Revival CIC - Awarded £500 - August 2021**

The donation was made to support a marketing campaign for the relaunch of the Sunday Markets.

##### **Shepton Mallet Bowls and Tennis Club - Awarded £837.50 - August 2021**

The donation was used to purchase disability aids for existing and prospective members.

##### **SMart CIC - Awarded £2,000 - August 2021**

The donation was to be used to support the cost of commissioning branding and building a website for SMart.

##### **The Mendip School Smallholding Project - Awarded £600 - August 2021**

The donation was to be used to support the cost of purchasing animals and secure pens for the forest school.



### **1st Shepton Mallet Guides - Awarded £1,975 - October 2021**

The donation was used to support the Guiding Unit with increased costs which would normally have been covered by fundraising.

### **Holly & Hawthorn - Awarded £200 - October 2021**

The donation was used to support the running of monthly Family Fund sessions.

### **League of Friends of Shepton Mallet Community Hospital - Awarded £350 - October 2021**

The donation was used towards the Christmas Concerts held at the community hospital.

### **Shepton Mallet Lantern Festival - Awarded £650 - October 2021**

The donation was used to fund the road closure costs for the festival and help with the rental of the space for the workshops.

### **Shepton Mallet Revival CIC - Awarded £500 - October 2021**

The donation was made to facilitate an entertainment package to support the Sunday Markets.

### **Shepton Mallet Sports FC Girls - Awarded £1,184 - October 2021**

The donation was made to support the cost of purchasing club kit.

### **The Rubbish Art Project - Awarded £1,300 - October 2021**

The donation was made to help facilitate free community workshops to create illuminated installations for a town event.

## **COMMUNITY GRANTS**

### **Shepton Mallet Library – Awarded £15,000 – April 2021**

The grant is part of a 5-year programme to support the library staying in the town centre.

### **Citizens Advice Mendip - Awarded £10,000 - April 2021**

The grant helps provide core funding to continue delivering advice and assistance to the residents of Shepton Mallet and environs.

### **Shepton Mallet Youth Club - Awarded £7,500 - April 2021**

The grant is used to help support the provision of the Shepton Mallet Youth Club.



**Mendip Community Transport - Awarded £1,500 - April 2021**

The grant funding contributes to the ongoing running costs of local transport for members of the community who do not have access to conventional public transport due to location or accessibility.

**Mid-Somerset Agricultural Society - Awarded £500- April 2021**

The grant was awarded to support the running of the annual show.

**Shepton Mallet Carnival Club - Awarded £1,300 - April 2021**

The grant will enable the club to pay insurance and storage costs which continue regardless of the Carnival event being cancelled.

**Shepton Mallet Snowdrop Festival – Awarded £4,000 – April 2021**

The grant was made to support the running of the annual Snowdrop Festival.

**SWEDA (Somerset & Wessex Eating Disorders Association) - Awarded £800 - April 2021**

The grant was used to support the organisation in supporting current and new clients.

**The Rubbish Art Project - Awarded £3,000 - April 2021**

The grant was used to support a year of activities for the LGBTQ+ community and its friends.

**The Wassail Theatre - Awarded £3,000 - April 2021**

The grant will be used to employ freelance community theatre practitioners to deliver a Youth Theatre project in Shepton Mallet.

The grant will be used to provide support and friendship to individuals who feel lonely, through befriending, individual support and establishing a Friendship Community.
