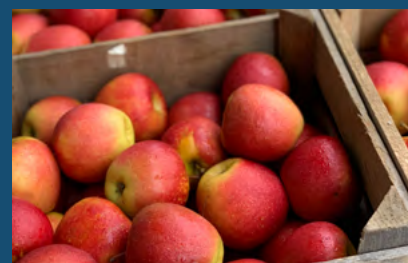


Community Spirit
